I have provided the Borough with a current Certificate of Insurance for the participating boat. I certify that I am in compliance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 12:7-61 et. Seq. For Boating Safety Education and, if applicable, possess a valid Boating Safety Certificate.

PROCEDURES AND RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. ALL BOAT OWNERS MUST PRESENT A CURRENT CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE FOR THE PARTICIPATING BOAT (NOT THE COVER PAGE OF THE POLICY). This may be obtained from your insurance agent.**
- 2. THERE WILL BE NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONSUMED ABOARD THE PARTICIPATING BOATS**
- 3. PERSONS PILOTING THE BOAT DURING THE PARADE MUST BE 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER**
- 4. PILOTS MUST ATTEND A SESSION OF A COAST GUARD CAPTAINS MEETING AND INSTRUCTION TO BE HELD ON Thursday, September 18 at 7:00 PM AT THE POINT PLEASANT ELKS, 820 ARNOLD AVE, POINT PLEASANT. THERE WILL BE A FREE DINNER INCLUDED (CASH BAR).
AT THIS SESSION YOU WILL RECEIVE YOUR BOAT'S NUMBER THAT MUST BE ATTACHED TO YOUR BOAT DURING THE PARADE (PLACING WILL BE INDICATED AT THE CAPTAINS' MEETING). DURING THIS SESSION THE COAST GUARD WILL ADVISE THE BOAT CAPTAINS OF THE COMMUNICATIONS CHANNELS THAT WILL BE UTILIZED DURING THE LINEUP AND THE PARADE.**
- 5. ALL VESSELS PARTICIPATING IN THE PARADE ARE SUBJECT TO ALL APPLICABLE LAWS AND REGULATIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE US COAST GUARD AND THE NEW JERSEY STATE POLICE.**

Application fee should be payable to Point Pleasant Beach and received by September 15, 2008, along with certificate of insurance (Point Pleasant Beach, 416 New Jersey Ave, Point Pleasant Beach, NJ 08742, attn: Boat Parade) .
